PRAYER: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Habeas Corpus, to direct the respondents 1 to 3' to produce the petitioner's daughter Pandi Meenakshi, aged about 25 years and her daughters Minor Sharmitha (age 5), D/o.Pandi Meenakshi, Subiksha (age 3), D/o. Pandi Meenakshi before this Court in person or body of detinue before this Court.

O R D E R

[Order of the Court was made by V.BHARATHIDASAN, J.]

Alleging that the petitioner's daughter one Pandi Meenakshi along with her two minor children found missing, suspecting that the 4th respondent has abducted her daughter, the petitioner has given a complaint before the 3rd respondent Police. Since no action has been taken on the complaint, the present Habeas Corpus Petition has been filed.

2. Mr.S.Ravi, the learned Standing Counsel for the State submitted that the detinue is a widow, now he eloped with the 4th

respondent and their whereabouts is not known and the 3rd respondent is conducting the investigation.

3. Considering the submissions, sine the detainees are found missing more than sixty days, the third respondent police is directed to proceed with the investigation, secure the detainees as early as possible and produce before the concerned Judicial Magistrate. On such production, the concerned Judicial Magistrate is directed to pass suitable orders regarding the custody of the detainees, in accordance with law.

4. With the above directions, the Habeas Corpus Petition is closed.
