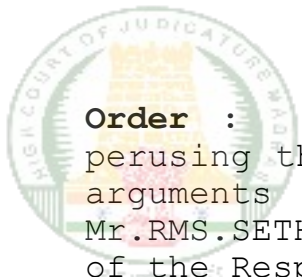

To call for the records and set aside the judgment passed by the Learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, Srivilliputhur, Virudhunagar District pronounced on 14.08.2019 made in CRL.A No.167 of 2012 and confirming the judgment pronounced on 22.10.2012 made in C.C.No.175 of 2008 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Court No.II, Srivilliputtur and acquit the petitioner from all the charges.

Crl M.P.(MD)No. 2783 of 2021 in Crl RC (MD)No.281/2021:

Petition filed praying that in the circumstances stated therein and in the petition filed therewith the High Court may be pleased to Suspend the sentence in C.C No. 175/2018 and to set aside the order and judgment passed by the Learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, Srivilliputhur, Virudhunagar District pronounced on 14.08.2019 made in CRL.A No.167/2012 and confirming the judgment pronounced on 22.10.2012 made in C.C.No.175 of 2008 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Court No.II, Srivilliputtur and acquit the petitioner from all the charges.



Order : This petition coming up for orders on this day, upon perusing the petition filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/S.M.P.RONIGA, Advocate for the petitioner and of Mr.RMS.SETHURAMAN, Additional Public Prosecutor(crl.side) on behalf of the Respondent, the court made the following order:-

This petition has been filed to relax the condition imposed on the petitioner in Crl.M.P(MD)No.2783 of 2021 in Crl.R.C.(MD)No.281 of 2021, dated 07.04.2021.

This petition is ordered accordingly.
