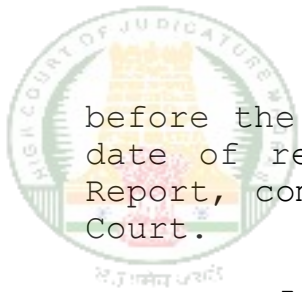
ORDER

2.The case of the petitioner is that the petitioner is the defacto complainant in Crime No.121 of 2021, on the file of the second respondent herein. A case has been registered for the offences punishable under Sections 417, 420 and 468 IPC, on the basis of a direction issued by the Judicial Magistrate, Papanasam in Cr.M.P No.879 of 2021.

3.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that investigation will be completed and Final Report will be filed within a period of four months.
