PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.439 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

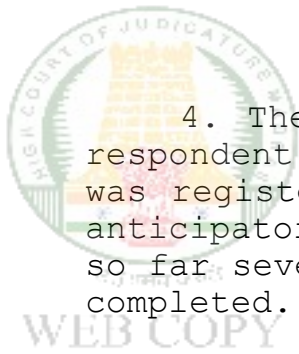
For Bail in Crime No. 830 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/A1, who was arrested on 13.07.2021 for the offence punishable under Section 306 I.P.C in Crime No.830 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the deceased who is the wife of the petitioner suspected that this petitioner is having illegal intimacy with another woman and committed suicide.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is an innocent and a false case has been foisted against him. He would also submit that the petitioner is in jail for more than 27 days, hence he may be granted bail.



4. The learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent would submit that apart from this petitioner, the case was registered as against seven persons. The Sessions Court granted anticipatory bail to the other accused. He would further submit that so far seven witnesses were examined and the investigation is almost completed.

5. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case, the fact that the co-accused had been granted anticipatory bail before the Sessions Court and the period of incarceration, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Aranthangi, and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m until further orders.

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]**.

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
