It appears that the petitioner has been granted anticipatory bail as early as on 06.08.2020 and after a period of one year, this application has been filed for extension of time, stating that due to the pandemic situation, the petitioner could not arrange the sureties. This Court is not satisfied with the reasons assigned in the petition. Therefore, this petition is dismissed, however, with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh application for anticipatory bail, if so advised.
