3.Since the petitioner has not complied with the conditions regularly, this petition is dismissed.

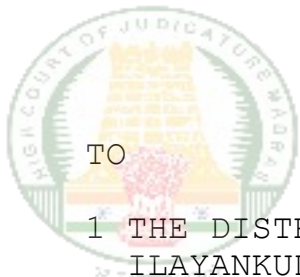
