Prayer : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the 3rd respondent to conduct further peace meeting upon his proceedings in Na.Ka.No.A2/8676/2019, dated 29.02.2020 along with providing adequate police protection by the 5th and 6th respondents to the temple namely by Arulmigu Sri Ranaveeraswamy, Sri Rakkachi Amman, Parivara Swamy and Karuppanna Swamy Temple situated at in Survey No.156/2 and 157/3 of Alandinatham, Sullangudi Panchayat, Manamadurai Taluk, Sivagangai District on the petitioner's



representation, dated 05.08.2021, within a period of stipulated time as fixed by this Court.

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ORDER

The petitioner seeks a direction to the third respondent to conduct a Peace Committee Meeting with adequate police protection in respect of the disputes relating to specific Temples in the Sivagangai District.

2. Mr.R.Baskaran, learned counsel for the State, accepts notice on behalf of respondents 1 to 6. On instructions, he submits that a Peace Committee Meeting has been convened at 4.00 p.m. today. He has also produced a copy of a communication dated 10.08.2021 from the Revenue Divisional Officer, Sivagangai District, in this regard. As regards police protection, he points out that the said communication has been copied to the relevant police officials and that, therefore, if deemed necessary, police protection would be made available.

3. In light of the aforesaid submissions by the learned counsel for the State and taking into account the communication dated 10.08.2021 from the Revenue Divisional Officer, Sivagangai, nothing survives for further adjudication in the present writ petition.

4. Accordingly, by recording the aforesaid, W.P.(MD).No.14703 of 2021 is disposed of on these terms without any order as to costs.

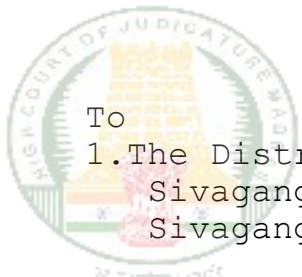
