PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-For Anticipatory bail in Crime No.610 of 2021 on the file of the Respondent police.

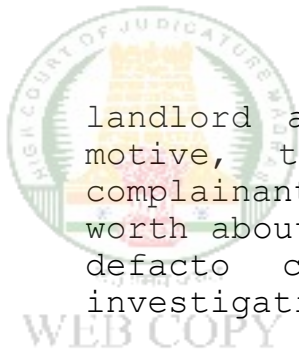
ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 143, 448, 427 and Section 380 of IPC in Crime No.610 of 2021, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 19.07.2021, the accused entered into the house of the defacto complainant and damaged CCTV camera, taken away materials which are worth about Rs.1,10,000/- and stolen a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- from the defacto complainant's house. Therefore, the present case came to be registered.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocents and they have been falsely implicated in this case.

4.The learned Government Advocate(Crl.side) appearing for the respondent police submitted that it is a dispute between the



landlord and tenant. He further submitted that due to previous motive, the accused entered into the house of the defacto complainant, damaged CCTV camera and taken away materials which are worth about Rs.1,10,000/- and stolen a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- from the defacto complainant's house. He further submitted that the investigation is yet to be completed.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the nature of allegations levelled against the petitioner and also the fact that it is a dispute between the landlord and tenant, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

6.Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or their appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Uthamapalayam, Theni District, on condition that the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further conditions that:

(a)the petitioners and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the learned Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity;

(b)the petitioners shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.

(c)the petitioners shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(d)the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(e)on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]***; and;

(f)if the accused/ petitioners thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
