2. In view of the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed as infructuous.

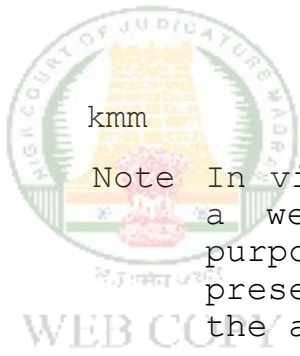
