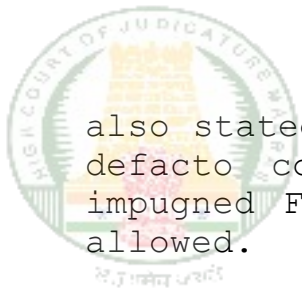

This criminal original petition has been filed to quash the FIR in Crime No.1387 of 2020 registered on the file of the first respondent for the offences under Sections 498(A) & 294 of IPC and Sections 67 & 67A of Information Technology (Amendment) Act.

2. The defacto complainant T.D.Rajeevi is present in person before this Court. She has been identified by her counsel K.R.Manimaran (Enrolment No.663/2009). The petitioners and the defacto complainant have entered into a compromise. The defacto complainant has no objection for quashing the impugned FIR. It is
