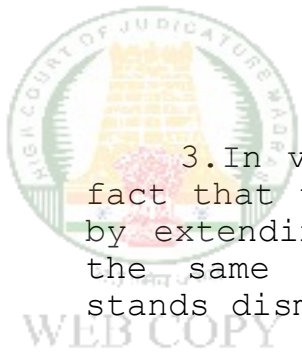

The petitioner, instead of surrendering before the Magistrate concerned, has filed this second application.
