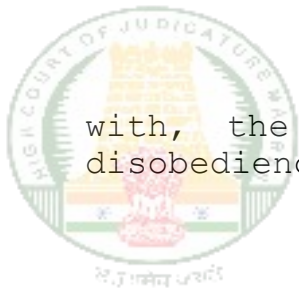
Prayer in WP(MD). 23789/ 2019 :
