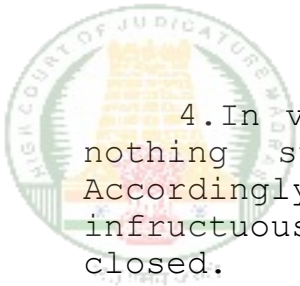

2.The petitioners were accused in a case registered under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act. The petition in Crl.M.P.No.6456 of 2019 came to be filed to re-open the case and mark certain documents and the same has been dismissed. Against which, the present petition came to be filed.

3.On 09.11.2021, this Court called for a report from the Court below as to the stage of the trial process. A report was submitted by the Court below stating that after full trial, the accused was convicted on 25.11.2019. Against which, the petitioner preferred an appeal in Crl.A.No.1 of 2020 before the learned Principal District Judge, Trichirappalli and the same is pending.
