PRAYER: Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for the issue of a Writ of Habeas Corpus, directing the respondents to produce the person or body of detenu, petitioner's daughter namely Kaleeswari, D/o. Selvam, aged 21 years, before this Court and set her at liberty.

O R D E R

(Order of the Court was made by V. BHARATHIDASAN, J.)

Alleging that the petitioner's daughter, by name, Kaleeswari, aged about 21 years, found missing, the petitioner has lodged a complaint before the second respondent police. Since no action has been taken by the second respondent to secure the detenu, the present Habeas Corpus Petition has been filed.

2.Today, when the matter is taken up for hearing, Mr.S.Ravi, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the State, on instructions, submitted since the petitioner arranging marriage for the detenu, she left the house. Now, the investigation reveals that she is working at Chennai, in a private company and she has also contacted the petitioner and assured him that she will return during Deepavali.

3.Considering the above circumstances, the detenu is not illegally detained and she is working at Chennai, no further



adjudication is required in this matter. Hence, the Habeas Corpus Petition is dismissed.
