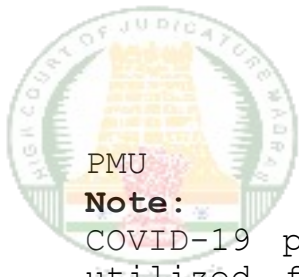
4. These writ petitions stand disposed of accordingly. No costs.
