PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.03 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners/A2 to A4 apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 417, 376(1) and 506(i) I.P.C, in Crime No.03 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the defacto complainant and one Prabhakaran/A1 who is the son of the petitioner nos. 1 and 2 loved each other. The said Prabhakaran had physical relationship with the defacto complainant by giving a promise that he would marry her. Thereafter, he refused to marry her at the instance of the petitioners. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners are innocents, they have not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution, but they have been falsely implicated in this case.



4.The learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police would submit that the investigation is yet to be completed.

5.This is the second anticipatory bail application. When the matter was taken up for hearing on 25.03.2021, there was a representation on behalf of the petitioners that they would arrange the marriage for the first accused with the defacto complainant and obtained an interim order. Thereafter, they failed to comply with the same. Now, the petitioners have filed an undertaking affidavit that they will arrange the marriage for the first accused with the defacto complainant.

6.Considering the undertaking affidavit filed by the first petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

7.Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or their appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Additional Mahila Court, Karur, on condition that the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further conditions that:

(a)the petitioners and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the learned Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity;

(b)the petitioners shall report before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation;

(c)the petitioners shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(d)the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(e)on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]***; and;

(f)if the accused/ petitioners thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.



8.It is open to the petitioners to produce the documents pertaining to the marriage before the respondent police. On such production of documents, the respondent police shall close the complaint at the earliest.
