Order : This petition coming up for orders on this day, upon perusing the petition filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of MR.M.MARAN, Advocate for the petitioners and of MR.P.KOTTAI CHAMY, Government Advocate (Criminal Side) on behalf of the Respondent, the court made the following order:-

This petition has been filed to relax the condition imposed against the petitioner in Crl.O.P(MD)No.8672 of 2021, dated 02.07.2021

2.During the last hearing on 13.09.2021, it was represented by the learned Government Advocate (Crl Side) appearing for the respondent that the petitioners have complied with the condition from 21.07.2021 to 10.08.2021 and thereafter they did not comply with the condition. However, the learned Counsel for the petitioners disputed the same that the petitioners have been complying with the condition without fail.

3.In view of above, this Court directed the respondent police to produce the relevant records before this Court. Accordingly, the

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respondent police produced the records, which show that the petitioners have complied with the condition upto 10.08.2021 and thereafter, they did not comply with the condition.

4. In the light of the above, this petition stands dismissed with cost of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand Only), which shall be paid by the petitioners together to the credit of the Government of Tamil Nadu, CMPRF in IOB, Secretariat Branch, Chennai-9 (Account No.11720 10000 00070, IFSC Code: IOBA0001172), within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
