Petition filed praying that in the circumstances stated therein and in the affidavit filed therewith the High Court may be pleased to grant six months time for reporting compliance of the order made in W.P.(MD).No.24751 of 2019 dated 22.11.2019 passed by this Honourable Court.

Prayer in CONT P(MD). 774/ 2021 :

To punish the Contemnors/Respondent for willfully disobeying and not complying with the order of this Honourable Court dated 22.11.2019 in WP(MD)No.24751 of 2019.

Prayer in WP(MD). 24751/ 2019 :

Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to pay interest at the rate of 18% per annum, for the period of delay from 01.07.2018 to 21.09.2019, in paying the amounts paid towards the terminal benefits of the petitioner namely, EPF Employees' Contribution, Gratuity and Encashment of earned / sick leaves, within a time frame as may be fixed by this Court and without affecting the petitioner's right to claim balance amounts towards those benefits.

ORDER : This petition coming up for orders on this day, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Mr.J.SENTHIL KUMARAIHAH, Advocate for the petitioner and of MR.S.ARUNACHALAM, Advocate on behalf of the Respondent, the court made the following order:-



Mr.J.Senthil Kumaraiah, learned counsel takes notice for the petitioner/ contemnor and Mr.S.Arunachalam, learned counsel takes notice for the respondent/petitioner.

2. This Sub Application has been filed by the petitioner/contemnor seeking six months time for reporting compliance of the order passed by this Court.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner/contemnor seeks four weeks time to comply with the order of this Court.

4.In view of the above, four weeks time is granted to comply with the order of this Court. However, it is made clear that in case, the petitioner/contemnor fail to comply with the order passed by this Court, a statutory notice will be issued against them on the next hearing date.

5.Accordingly, the Sub Application is ordered.
