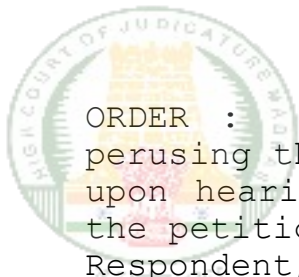
Prayer in CONT P(MD). 593/ 2021 :

Prayer in WP(MD). 24677/ 2019 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court Directing the respondents to pay interest at the rate of 18 percent per annum, for the period of delay from 01.06.18 to 21.09.19, in paying the amounts paid towards the terminal the pension benefits of the petitioner namely EPF Employees Contribution, Gratuity, Encashment of Earned/Sick Leaves and Commutated Value of Pension, within a time frame as may be fixed by this Honourable Court and without affecting his right to claim

2. This Sub Application has been filed by the petitioner/ first contemnor seeking six months time for reporting compliance of the order passed by this Court.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner/ first contemnor seeks four weeks time to comply with the order of this Court.

4.In view of the above, four weeks time is granted to comply with the order of this Court. However, it is made clear that in case, the petitioner/contemnors fail to comply with the order passed by this Court, a statutory notice will be issued against them on the next hearing date.

5.Accordingly, the Sub Application is ordered.
