Prayer in WP(MD). 27385/ 2019 :

Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ of mandamus, to direct the respondent to pay interest at the rate of 18% per annum, for the period of delay from 01.08.2018 to 21.09.2019, in paying the amounts paid towards the terminal benefits of the petitioner namely EPF Employee's Contribution, Gratuity and Encashment of Earned/Sick Leaves within a time frame as may be fixed by this court and without affecting his right to claim balance amounts towards those benefits.
