It appears that the petitioners have been granted anticipatory bail as early as on 07.06.2021 and after a period of three months, this application has been filed for extension of time, stating that due to the pandemic situation, the petitioners could not mobilise the fund and comply with the condition. This Court is not satisfied with the reasons assigned in the petition. Therefore, this petition is dismissed, however, liberty is granted to the petitioners to file a fresh application for anticipatory bail, if so advised.
