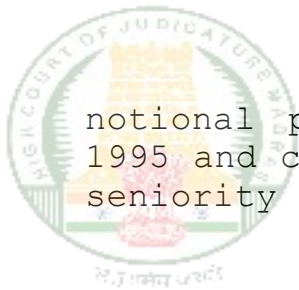

PRAYER: Contempt Petition is filed under Section 11 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, to punish the contemnors i.e., the Respondents 1 to 4 for their deliberate and willful disobedience of the order of this Court made in W.P(MD) No.5296 of 2019 dated 20.01.2020.

PRAYER IN W.P(MD) No.5296 of 2019 : Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, to call for the records pertaining to the impugned proceedings of the third respondent dated 23.02.2015 bearing No.Se.Mu.Aanai.No.11671/2014/Pa2 and quash the same in so far as the portion of order fixing the date 02.01.2015 as crucial date for receiving the arrears by the petitioner and consequently direct the respondents to confer



notional promotion as Forest Watcher with effect from the year 1995 and consequential promotions and monetary benefits as per the seniority list drawn in the year 1994-1995 on the petitioner.

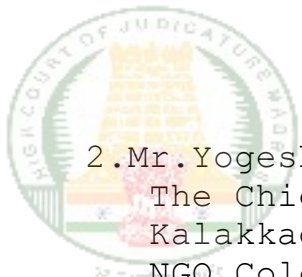
