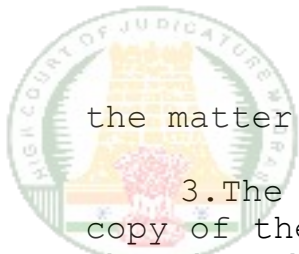

It has been stated in the closure report that based upon the complaint given by the petitioner, enquiry was undertaken in C.P.No.262 of 2021 and during the course of enquiry, both parties have appeared and the petitioner herein gave a statement to the effect that he is ready to pay installment and also ready to withdraw this petition. Similarly the fifth respondent has also given a statement that he is ready to receive the amount from the petitioner in installments. Based upon the above said terms, the complaint given by the petitioner came to be closed.

4. Since the complaint has been closed, nothing survives for further consideration or direction in this petition.

5. This petition is disposed of as infructuous. No costs.
