Prayer in CMP(MD) No.6998 of 2019:

Petition filed praying that in the circumstances stated therein and in the affidavit filed therewith the High Court may be pleased to condone the delay of 740 days delay in filing the above appeal as against the order dated 14.06.2017 passed by this Honourable Court in WA(MD)No.717 of 2017.

Prayer in REV.A(MD)SR No.54625 of 2019:

To review the order passed in WA(MD)No.717 of 2017 dated 14.06.2017.

Prayer in WA(MD)No.717/2017 :

Writ Appeal filed under Clause 15 of Letters Patent, against the order dated 11/02/2014 made in WP(MD)No.13583 of 2013.

Prayer in WP(MD)No.13583/2013 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a writ, order or direction or any other writ in the nature of a writ of certiorarified mandamus calling for the records relating to the impugned order of the 3rd respondent in Na.Ka.P5/31115/2011 dated 22.05.2013 and quash the same and consequently direct the first respondent to reinstate the petitioner in service as per the award dated 15.09.2010 made in



ID.No.53 of 1999 on the file of Labour Court, Madurai with full wages with effect from 15.09.2010 within a reasonable time as may be fixed by this Hon'ble Court.

ORDER : This petition coming up for orders on this day, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Mr.K.P.KRISHNADOSS, Special Government Pleader for the petitioners, the Court made the following order:-

(Order of the Court was made by T.S.Sivagnanam, J.)

We have heard Mr.K.P.Krishnadoss, learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the petitioners.

This petition has been filed to condone the delay of 740 days in filing the review petition.

We have perused the affidavit filed in support of the condone delay petition which consists of 7 paragraphs. Paragraphs 1 to 6 pertain to the various orders by the learned Single Bench and the judgment of the Division Bench. Paragraph 7 is stated to be the reasons as to why the review could not be filed in time. On perusal of the said paragraph, it is seen that the only statement is that the papers were sent to the higher officials for administrative sanction and after the sanction they approached the learned Special Government Pleader for opinion and thereafter the review has been filed and there is a delay of 740 days. There is absolutely no explanation for the inordinate delay. As the delay remains unexplained, we are not inclined to condone the same. Accordingly, the petition is dismissed.
