3. The petitioner is given liberty to approach the second respondent. The second respondent will take action as per law. This writ petition stands disposed of accordingly. No costs.

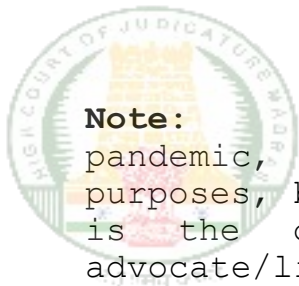
