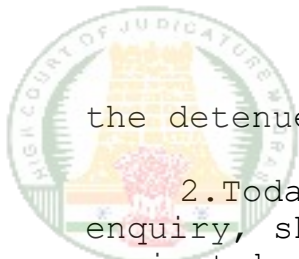

O R D E R

(Order of the Court was made by V. BHARATHIDASAN, J.)

Alleging that the petitioner's daughter, by name, Swetha, aged about 17 years, found missing from 03.09.2021, the petitioner has given a complaint, before the second respondent police. Since, no action has been taken by the second respondent police to secure



the detainee, the present Habeas Corpus Petition has been filed.

2.Today, the detainee has been produced before this Court and on enquiry, she submitted that since her parents are arranging marriage against her wish, she left the parental home and stayed at Chennai. Now, she wants to go with the parents and she has not been kidnapped or illegally detained by anybody.

3.The parents are also present before this Court. The petitioner, father of the detainee, expresses his willingness to take back the detainee.

4.Since the detainee is secured and she also expresses her willingness to go with the petitioner / father, this Habeas Corpus Petition is closed setting the detainee at liberty and permitting her to go with the petitioner.
