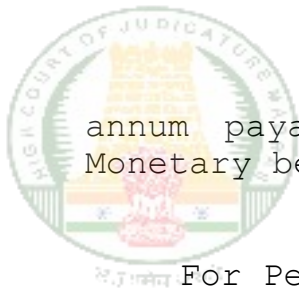

**PRAYER:** Contempt Petition is filed under Section 11 of the Contempt of Court Act, 1971, to punish the respondents for their wilful disobedience of the order of this Court in W.P.(MD)No.215 of 2019, dated 04.01.2019.

**Prayer in WP(MD). 215/ 2019 :**

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court To issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to revise the petitioners Pay Notionally with effect from 01.01.2016 and to revise his pension and other terminal benefits payable to him with effect from 01.10.2017 and also direct to pay the difference in terminal benefits such as Gratuity, Commutation and Leave Salary etc. and also pension arrears with effect from 01.10.2017 together with interest at the rate of 12% per



annum payable to him to till the date of payment of the said Monetary benefits based on the 25 Board Meeting.
