ORDER

On that basis peace committee resolution has been adopted.

Since an agreement has been reached between the parties in the peace



committee meeting, nothing survives for further consideration in this petition and the prayer sought for in this petition has become infructuous.

3.This criminal original petition is dismissed as infructuous.
