PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

**PRAYER :-**

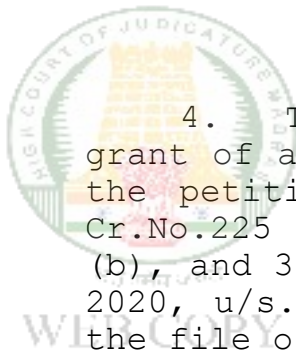
For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.680 of 2021 on the file of the Respondent Police.

**ORDER :** The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/sole accused, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent Police, for the offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 353 and 506(i) IPC, in Crime No.680 of 2021, on the file of the respondent Police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the defacto complainant is working as a Special Sub Inspector, Kenikkarai Police Station, Ramanathapuram District. On 31.08.2021, when the petitioner/accused was remanded in the Court in Crime No.225 of 2009 (previous case), he abused the defacto complainant in filthy language and threatened him with dire consequences. Hence, the present complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is an innocent, he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case.



4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) opposed for grant of anticipatory bail on the ground that apart from this case, the petitioner is also involved in two previous cases, viz., in Cr.No.225 of 2009, u/s. 341, 294(b), 307 IPC and 147, 148, 341, 294 (b), and 302 IPC on the file of the respondent Police and Cr.No.6 of 2020, u/s. 147, 148, 294(b), 307, 323, 324, 342 and 506(ii) IPC on the file of the respondent Police.

5. Considering the nature of offence and the antecedent of the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. In the result, the Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
