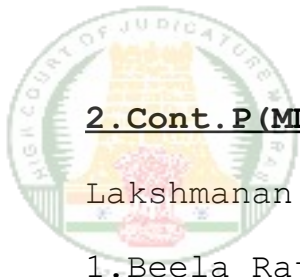

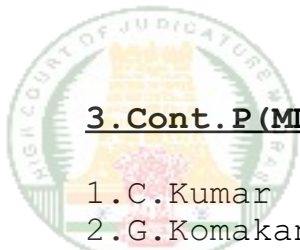

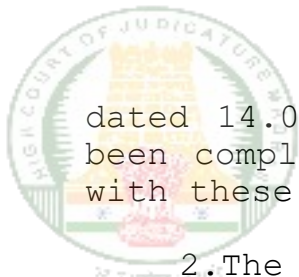
Prayer in WP(MD) . 14612/ 2020 :
