For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.335 of 2021 on the file of the Respondent Police

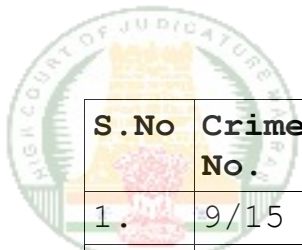
ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Section 379 of IPC in Crime No.335 of 2021, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner waylaid the defacto complainant and snatched the mobile phone from the defacto complainant. Hence the complaint.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case.

4.It is reported by the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) that the petitioner is having nine previous cases to his credit. The details of the previous cases are as follows:
