2. In the light of the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Writ Petition is dismissed as abated. No costs.

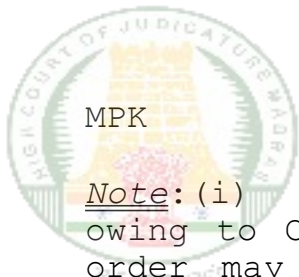
