PRAYER :-

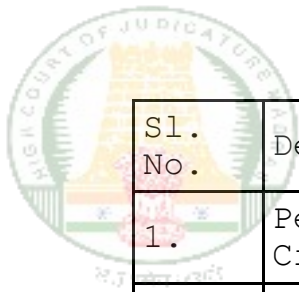
For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.266 of 2021 on the file of the respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :

The petitioner apprehending arrest for the offence punishable under Sections 379 IPC r/w 21(1) of Mines and Mineral (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 in Crime No.14 of 2021 on the file of the respondent Police seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The prosecution case is that the petitioner along with other accused illegally transported one unit oodai sand. Hence the complaint.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl Side) appearing for the respondent submitted the petitioner and other accused transported oodai sand and he has also involved in six other cases, of which, five cases are similar in nature, as follows:

4.Considering the antecedents of the petitioner that he is involved in several other cases, of which five cases are similar in nature, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, this petition stands dismissed.
