This criminal original petition has been filed for quashing the FIR in Crime No.226 of 2017 registered on the file of the first respondent.

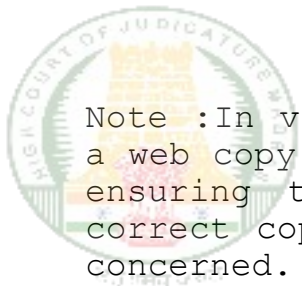
