2.Considering the pleading of the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, the Writ Petition stands dismissed as withdrawn. No costs.

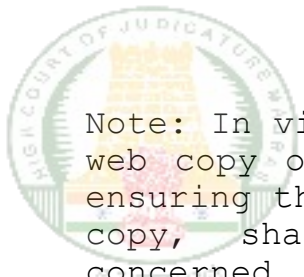
