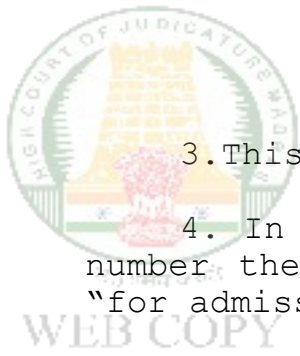
PRAYER IN CMA(MD)SR.No.70712 of 2019:
