This petition has been filed to extend the time which has been granted to the petitioner by an order of this Court dated 22.03.2021 in Crl.M.P(MD) No.2067 of 2021 in Crl.O.P.(MD)No.10693 of 2020 dated 22.03.2021.

2. It appears that the petitioner has been granted anticipatory bail as early as on 02.11.2020 and after a period of three months, he has moved a petition for extension of time in Crl.M.P.(MD)No.2067 of 2021. This Court, vide order 22.03.2021, granted further time of two weeks. Even thereafter, the petitioner has not executed



sureties and he filed this application for further extension of time by stating that due to the election, the petitioner could not able to contact the officials for getting surety certificate and thereafter, the petitioner was also suffered with COVID-19. This Court is not satisfied with the reasons assigned in the petition. Therefore, this petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh application for anticipatory bail, if so advised.
