of the respondent Police.

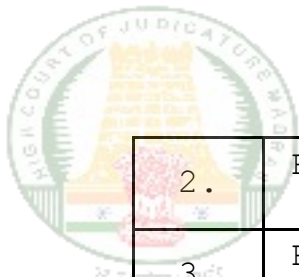
ORDER : The Court made the following order :

The petitioner, apprehending arrest for the offence under Sections 379 IPC and Section 21(4) of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, in Crime No.199 of 2021 seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The prosecution case is that the petitioner along with other accused has transported stones without valid permission. Hence the complaint.

3.When the matter is taken up for hearing the learned Government Advocate (Crl Side) appearing for the respondent submitted that the petitioner has involved in three previous cases, one of which is of similar in nature, as follows:

S1. No.	Details	Sections of Law
1.	Radhapuram Police Station Crime No.203 of 2011	Section 379 IPC and Section 21(1) of the MMDR Act



2.	Radhapuram Police Station Crime No.15 of 2012	Section 294(b), 323, 506 (ii) IPC
3.	Radhapuram Police Station Crime No.171 of 2021	Section 294(b) and 506(ii) IPC

4.Considering the antecedents of the petitioner that he is involved in three other cases including one similar offence, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, this petition stands dismissed.
