PRAYER :-

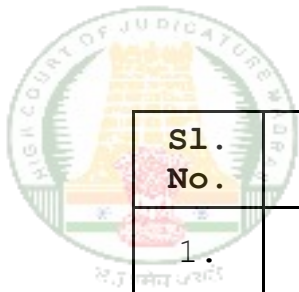
For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.659 of 2021 on the file

ORDER : The Court made the following order :

The petitioner, apprehending arrest for the offence under
Section 379 IPC and Sections 21(1) and 21(2) Mines and Minerals
(Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 in Crime No.659 of 2021 seeks
anticipatory bail.

2.The prosecution case is that the petitioner has illegally
loaded sand in two tractors. Hence the complaint.

3.When the matter is taken up for hearing the learned
Government Advocate (Crl Side) appearing for the respondent
submitted that the petitioner has involved in the following five
previous cases, of which, two are similar in nature.

4.Considering the antecedents of the petitioner that he is involved in five other cases, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, this petition stands dismissed.
