



anticipatory bail, that the petitioner is A.4 in this case, that A.1 and A.2 were already arrested and released on bail, that the petitioner is the main supplier and that the investigation is yet to be completed. He would further submit that the petitioner is having four previous cases, out of which, two cases are similar in nature.

5. Considering the seriousness and the gravity of the offences, that the investigation is pending as stated by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor and that the petitioner is having two previous cases for similar offences, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
