ORDER

The learned Judicial Magistrate, Natham is directed to process the final report that has been presented by the Investigation Officer as per rules. After the process is over, compliance report must be submitted to the Registry.

5.With the aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.

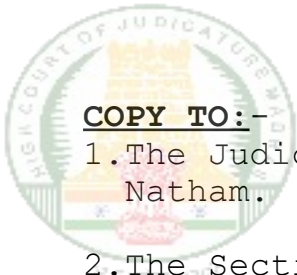
