2.Permission granted. Recording the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner this criminal original petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

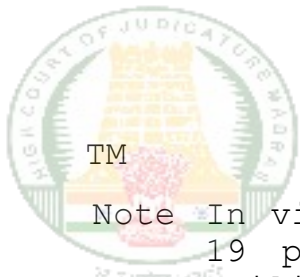
