### **O R D E R**

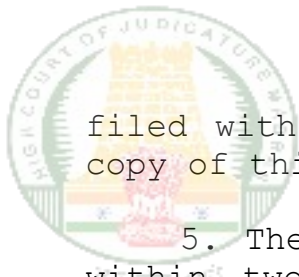
Heard the learned counsel on either side.
