2.Mr.R.Erottuchamy, learned Government Advocate, who accepts notice on behalf of the respondents, on instructions, would contend that the petitioner abandoned his vehicle on road and the two wheeler Bajaj Platina bearing registration No.TN-72-CY-1073 is in Vijayanarayanam police station and the Inspector of Police, Vijayanarayanam Police Station, is ready to return the vehicle to the present petitioner. He would further contend that no complaint is registered against the present petitioner.



3.This submission is admitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

4.In the circumstances, the petitioner is directed to go over to Vijayanarayanam police station and get his vehicle back, after producing necessary documents relating to the vehicle.

5.With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
