Prayer in WP(MD). 8284 of 2020 :

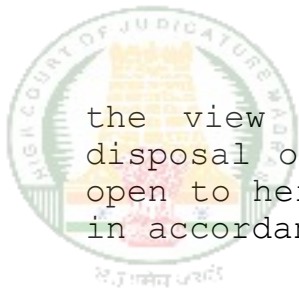

O R D E R

It is stated that the respondents have preferred an appeal in connected matter, wherein, interim order has been granted against the order of the writ court. Therefore, it would not be appropriate to simultaneously adjudicate the contempt petition. Hence, the contempt petition is closed. However, in case, the petitioner is of



the view that the disobedience continues, even after the final disposal of the writ appeal itself, if it is in her favour, it is open to her to exercise her rights with regard to such disobedience, in accordance with law.
