3.Recording the same, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.

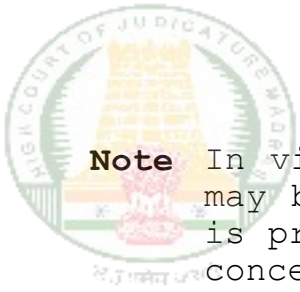
