2.Permission Granted. In view of the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn. No costs.

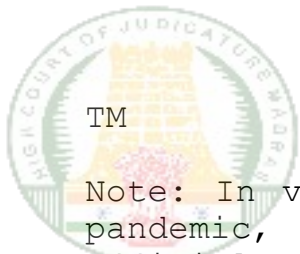
