This writ petition was disposed of by this Court on 18.11.2021, with a direction to the respondents to settle the terminal benefits to the petitioner, within a period of twelve weeks and to report the compliance.

2.Today(05.11.2024), this writ petition is listed under the caption "for reporting compliance". The learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents by referring a proceedings of the Special Officer of Batalagundu
