2020, submitted by the petitioner, after affording reasonable opportunity to the respondents 3 to 5, on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order / uploading of the order.

4. With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
