2.Accordingly, this criminal original petition is dismissed as infructuous. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.

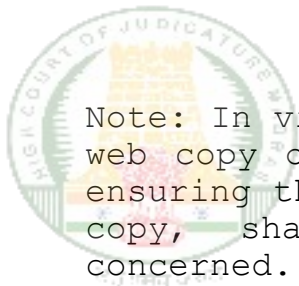
